Shirts

White polo shirt with our embroidered school logo. These are available to purchase from the school's approved supplier.

Trousers/Skirts

Trousers must be plain black in an appropriate tailored style. Jeans, leggings/jeggings or skinny trousers are **not** acceptable. Belts must be plain black.

Skirts must be plain black, A-line style and knee length. Short skirts, clingy or lycra skirts are **not** acceptable.

Trousers and skirts must not have any decoration or embellishments, motifs, coloured buttons or coloured zips.

Sweatshirts

Royal blue sweatshirt with embroidered Cwmtawe logo (may be purchased from the school's approved supplier). No hoodies or cardigans to be worn around the school.

In warm weather, the sweatshirt may be removed. However, pupils are **not** permitted to wear sweatshirts without the polo shirt.

Footwear

Plain black 'formal style' leather shoes with black laces (where appropriate) or plain black trainers should be worn.

Coloured trainers, boots, canvas shoes or excessive heels are **not** permitted. Footwear should **not** have coloured embellishments or branding.

Socks/tights must be white, grey or black. Brightly coloured socks or trainer socks are **not** permitted.

Jewellery

A standard watch is permitted. Smart watches and 'Fitbits' are **not** allowed.

The only jewellery permitted is one pair of small stud or sleeper earrings in the lower lobe of each ear.

Unusual hair styles or unusual hair colours are **not** allowed. Headbands must be small, plain and without decoration. Hats/caps are **not** to be worn.

Facial piercings of any kind are **not** acceptable. Ear stretchers are **not** allowed. No nail art or excessive make-up.
